PROJECT: BLUE HERON BOWL CEREMONY RING

LOCATION: Camp Kiwanis @ Pipsico Scout Reservation

OBJECTIVE: To refurbish all seating areas within the campfire ring area. This will include new benches, landscaping all walkways, terracing all aisles, and seating areas, etc.

PROJECTED START / END DATE: January - June 2020

TOOLS NEEDED: Bow saws, hand saws, chain saws, flat and pointed tip shovels, garden rakes, battery operated screw drivers, assorted hand tools as needed, safety goggles, gloves, levels, wood material as needed.

SKILL(S) NEEDED: Safe chain saw operation skills (must be BSA qualified), wood working skills, basic groundskeeping skills, must be able to perform repetitive manual labor tasks.

PROJECT SPECIFICS: This project will focus on the total replacement of all benches in the Blue Heron Bowl campfire ring areas located in Camp Kiwanis. All old bench material will need to be removed, grounds re-terraced, and new support posts and seating installed. Surrounding areas will need to be cleaned up and all debris removed to appropriate areas. Aisles will need to be terraced correctly with new timbers put in place to prevent soil erosion. All pathways to/from each campfire ring will need clearing and debris removal.

PROJECT MANAGER:

NOTE: The project manager will be responsible for keeping an accurate participation log of all attendees, dates worked, and hours worked. Must also work with the camp Ranger to clarify project details as needed and to coordinate all work times, dates, tool usage.
