PROJECT: BULK STORAGE CLEANUP

LOCATION: Camp Kiwanis, Pipsico Scout Reservation

**OBJECTIVE:** To facilitate the removal of all metal and wood debris.

PROJECTED START / END DATE: January – April 2020

TOOLS NEEDED: Gloves, goggles, hammers, chains or rope, battery operated reciprocating saw or circular saw, metal cutters, chain saw(s) w/appropriate safety gear. One or more open utility trailers with vehicles to tow (min 10-12' in length), tractor.

SKILL(S) NEEDED: Tractor operator skills (can teach), chain saw operation (must be BSA certified), knowledge of appropriate safety requirements while handling scrap metal, knowledge of safe trailer towing practices, and the ability to perform repetitive manual labor evolutions.

PROJECT SPECIFICS: This project will entail the complete removal of all metal as well as wood scrap material located in Camp Kiwanis in the area known as "bulk or long term storage" for either recycling or burning.

All metal scrap must be taken to a designated area near the barn at the front of camp for further removal via recycle dump bin. All wood scrap material will be taken to the burn area located at the open common area near the Maintenance shop building, neatly stacked for burning. All other material not of metal scrap or wood origin will need to be broken down for discard in camp garbage dumpsters.

The goal is to facilitate the clean up of all "trash or scrap debris" in bulk storage and return the area to its natural setting.
