PROJECT: <u>DAM SPILLWAY CLEANUP</u>

LOCATION: Camp Lions, Pipsico Scout Reservation

OBJECTIVE: To clear all overgrowth and restore the flow of water from Lake

Beasley.

PROJECTED START / END DATE: January – March 2020

TOOLS NEEDED: Chain saws, chain saw safety equipment including gloves, goggles or appropriate face shield and chaps, bow saws, loppers, waders (thigh to chest length), work gloves, gas powered weed-eaters.

SKILL(S) NEEDED: Experience in the safe and proper use of chain saws (must be BSA qualified), the ability to perform repetitive manual labor tasks, able to lift 30-50 pounds.

PROJECT SPECIFICS: This project will encompass the cleaning and clearing of surrounding overgrowth from both sides of the spillway of the dam. Some low – medium brush and small trees will need to be either cut or trimmed that have encroached into the spillway area. All cut debris will need to be removed from the area. Surrounding areas will need trimmed down and supporting rock areas cleared of vine growth. Limited work will also need to be done from the small walkway along the top of the dam to clear debris that has piled onto and in the spillway opening obstructing the flow of water (adult only).
